LEGISLATIVE UPDATES:

The Federal government shutdown is finally over. Democrats stubbornly stopped funding for our military, air-traffic controllers, and poor families for NOTHING! Eight Democrat senators crossed party lines to end the shutdown. We should never forget that they did this to try to protect Senator Chuck Schumer and to gin up Democrats before the November election.

The Redistricting Commission voted unanimously for Congressional maps that will give Republican 2 additional seats. If the Commission failed to act, the legislature could have voted for a map, but it would be subject to a Democrat driven ballot referendum. Democrats would likely pour millions of dollars into Ohio and likely would not have resulted in additional seats for Republicans.

The Statehouse is heading towards the end of 2025 legislative activity. The Senate this week will consider and vote on several property tax reform measures designed to address rising property tax bills. The Senate rejected the House's marijuana and hemp bills. A conference committee is working on a solution that may be voted on this coming week. The Congress, however, acted to ban intoxicating hemp and to close the 2018 hemp loophole that has been exploited to sell intoxicating hemp in your corner gas stations and stores. This Federal action will have an impact on the actions at the Ohio Statehouse. I am proud to say that the Senate passed the Abbey Gate Remembrance Day bill sponsored by me and Senator Roegner unanimously. It now goes to the House for consideration. We must never forget the disastrous pull out of Afghanistan by Joe Biden.

The National Federation of Republican Women (NFRW) established the Caring for America program in 1999 to encourage state federations and clubs to actively participate in at least one community service program. Caring for America programs may be completed by the state or club individually or in collaboration with other community agencies. Republican women always step forward when they see an area that needs assistance, whether it is direct or through donations of needed food or other commodities. The NFRW Caring for America Committee compiles a comprehensive list of activities that is provided to all Federated Republican women's clubs.

The Caring for America Committee consists of region leaders from various member states who each work with the state presidents in their assigned region to promote the Caring for America program. These region leaders meet before the national biennial convention to review submissions from state presidents to determine the NFRW Caring for America Award winners in each size category. The NFRW recognizes each winner with a certificate at the biennial convention.
