**LEGISLATIVE UPDATES:**

**S.B. 104** dubbed the Bathroom Bill takes effect on February 25, which prohibits Ohio public and private schools, colleges, and universities from allowing individuals to use multi-person restrooms and locker rooms that don't correspond to the gender they were assigned at birth. Schools may make accommodations for students, but those accommodations must be for single-occupancy.

**H.B. 250** Cell phone law requires school districts to adopt policies limiting cell phone use during school hours. These policies must be in effect no later than July 1, 2025.

**H.B. 214** Religious Expression Days allows all Ohio students to have up to 3 approved absences to participate in religious expression.

Ohio minimum wage increased on January 1, 2025 as required by a 2006 Ohio Constitutional amendment. Minimum wage is now \$10.70 and \$5.25 for tipped workers.

**H.B. 173** requires hospitals to publish certain price information to the public.

Governor DeWine just signed the Parents' Bill of Rights, which ensures parents are informed of what is going on in their children's lives while at school. Governor DeWine also signed Braden's Law, which prohibits sexual extortion online.

Rep. Matt Huffman (R-Lima) was unanimously elected Speaker of the House and Sen. Rob McColley was elected President of the Senate.

In Congress, Congressman Mike Johnson was elected Speaker of the House and Senator John Thune was elected Majority Leader of the Senate. The U.S. House passed the Laken Riley Act requiring Homeland Security to detain non-US residents who are arrested for burglary, theft, larceny, or shoplifting. It is expected to pass in the Senate.
