LEGISLATIVE UPDATES:

As we head into fall, the legislature will return to Columbus with many issues on its plate. The budget included several property tax reforms that Gov. DeWine vetoed. The House met to override one provision that made clarifying changes to ballot language in levies, removed political subdivisions authority to charge new replacement tax levies, and removed the authority of school districts to levy emergency or substitute levies, as well as a renewal with an increase and combined school income tax and fixed sum property tax levies. It is expected that further overrides will take place this fall. All overrides must start in the House. The Senate will then meet to vote on the overrides.

After the vetoes, DeWine created a property tax working group. They are currently meeting. Many issues among many discussed are the feasibility of cutting tax bills by consolidating local jurisdictions. Looming large over the discussion is the statewide ballot issue to abolish property taxes entirely. This is estimated to be a \$23 billion cut to municipalities, townships, police, fire, and schools across the state. Legislators continue to work on property tax reform. Rep. Gary Click introduced 3 bills 1) HB 420 "Discontinuing the Continuum" 2) HB421 "Arresting the Inside Millage" and 3) The Triumph of the Taxpayer. Property taxes will be a major issue in the legislature going forward.

Another major item is Congressional Redistricting. As background, Ohioans approved a constitutional amendment in 2018 to change the process. The legislature draws the map. If the map fails to pass with bipartisan support, the responsibility falls to the Ohio Redistricting Commission. The Commission is 7 members: One appointed by the Senate President, one appointed by the Speaker of the House, one appointed by the Senate Minority Leader, one appointed by the House Minority Leader, the Governor, the Auditor, and the Secretary of State. If that map does not get bipartisan support, the map is only in effect for 4 years. In March of 2022, the Redistricting Commission adopted a map without Democrat support. By September 30, 2025, the legislature must pass a new congressional map by a 3/5 vote in each chamber including 1/2 of the Democrats. If that does not happen, the seven-member Redistricting Commission must adopt a plan by the end of October with support of the Democrats on the Commission. If the Commission does not adopt a map, the legislature must pass a map by the end of November. This would require only a simple majority vote. You can propose congressional redistricting maps at redistricting.legislature.ohio.gov Congressional redistricting will be a hot button issue and control of Congress depends on a Republican majority. As always, I am happy to answer any of your questions.
