LEGISLATIVE UPDATES:

Stark County recently had some big names visit. Vice President Vance came to Canton to speak at Metallus Co. He listed the incredible accomplishments and successes of President Trump's first six months in office, especially the One Big Beautiful Bill—More money for the border, increase in military and defense support, no tax on tips, no tax on overtime, no tax on social security, and preserving the tax cuts of 2017. This is on top of new pro-America trade deals and peace deals around the world.

Secretary of HUD Turner visited to tour the work of Canton for All People and how they are transforming lives with housing and community.

The legislature is on recess and will return in September. Last week campaign finance reports came out last week for the first half of 2025. The House Republican Campaign Committee reported having \$2 million cash on hand while the House Democrat Committee reported having just \$65,000 cash on hand. Senate Republicans reported \$2.16 million with the Democrats reporting \$258,877. President Pro-Tem Bill Reineke announced he is seeking the role of Senate President. Senator Jerry Cirino has also announced he is running for Senate President to succeed Senator McColley at the end of 2026.

Both leading candidates for Governor claimed record fundraising but Vivek Ramaswamy has a 10-fold advantage over Amy Acton.

And Sherrod Brown announced he is running for U.S. Senate against Senator Jon Husted. I can hear your groans as you read this. Brown was resoundingly defeated by Bernie Moreno and we all must work to make sure Brown never gets to D.C.
